ISSAEF announces Its 2011 Scholarship Program

ISSAEF Supports ISSA Chapter Scholarship Efforts

The ISSA Education Foundation (ISSAEF) is pleased to announce its 2011 scholarship program aimed at financially assisting those outstanding students who are working towards a degree in Information Security. The ISSAEF was formed in 2003 by the ISSA International Board as a separate 501c(3) not-for-profit organization to foster, support research, develop and provide education and training in the information security field. Since its formation, ISSAEF has issued four separate scholarships, two each at the undergraduate level and graduate levels.

Last year's scholarship winners were undergraduate Sarah Kennedy attending Murray State University and graduate student Mindy Bollinger attending Capella University, Minneapolis, MN, both of whom received \$1,000 toward their studies. Mindy says of her grant, "I am grateful that the ISSA Education Foundation scholarship could help keep my debt at bay. With their help, I will be able to continue to pursue my goal of information technology security and assurance - and to help in the worldwide effort to protect both civilians and the government sector against technological and/or cyber criminals."

Applications for the two \$1,000 scholarships to be granted in 2011 will be accepted beginning September 1, 2011, and all paperwork must be turned in prior to December 1, 2011.
