This Scholarship Application, unofficial transcript and a letter of recommendation (two letters preferred) must be received no later than June 30, 2020, 11:59 PM PST, for consideration by the Scholarship Committee.

Early, late or incomplete applications may not be accepted.

Names and photographs of the scholarship recipients may be published on the ISSA Education Foundation website (issaef.org), in the ISSA Journal and on the Foundation social media pages, as soon as confirmed, following the close of the application submission period and final selection.

Scholarship Eligibility Criteria that will be evaluated includes:

<u>Academic Excellence:</u> Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher for undergraduates or 3.0 or higher (on a 4.0 scale) for graduates. Please attach an unofficial transcript from the current or most recent institution.

<u>Work Experience:</u> Security-related work experience and/or completed security coursework.

<u>Community Service:</u> Volunteer work in the cybersecurity, information technology field, or other relevant areas.

Extracurricular Activities: relating to information security, such as volunteer work, attendance at conferences, publications, and cybersecurity competitions. Be sure to highlight any publications or conference presentations.

<u>Personal Statement:</u> A short narrative describing the applicant's background, chosen academic program, interests and goals in the information security field.

<u>Relevant Certifications/Clubs:</u> List memberships in cybersecurity or information technology professional organizations, certifications or relevant student clubs.

<u>Letters of Recommendation:</u> At least one letter of recommendation with two preferred, such that, one includes a recommendation from a current/former instructor/faculty, cybersecurity employer or cybersecurity association member.

<u>Chapter Scholarships:</u> Must be attending a university or college in the chapter region.
